

Valleys Hard Enduro May 2025 - Final instructions

1. Gate Opening Times

If you have selected and purchased Priority Parking, you can arrive on site from 12noon on Thursday 8th May 2025

- Friday 9th May 2025 – Open 12:00 – Close 21:00
- Saturday 10th May 2025 – Open 06:00 – Close 23:00
- Sunday 11th May 2025 – Open 07:00 – Close 22:00



2. Entry

You will soon receive a QR code to your email used on registration for your rider entry and if purchased, a QR code will also be sent for your pit crew member

YOUR PIT CREW MEMBER MUST ARRIVE IN THE SAME VEHICLE OR THEY WILL INCUR EXTRA CHARGES

If your pit crew cannot attend in the same vehicle you need to contact us as they will need to purchase a discounted ticket and they will NOT be situated in the pits – they will be in the day parking area

You will need to download the [Eventbrite app](#) or print these off to gain access to site – Please ensure you have these to hand to help with queues on arrival.



You will be given a car parking ticket on arrival and this must be on show in your vehicles all weekend. This will also be your entry ticket to regain access on Sunday (if leaving site) So please keep these safe

3. Administration

- 3.1 Administration will be at the main white marquee on
- Friday 9th May 2025 from 12:00 – 21:00
- 3.2 You will receive your race number at administrative control and must be placed on the front of your bike. This will be your race number throughout the weekend and will not change (We will supply the race sticker)
- 3.3 You must submit:-
- * Either a ACU Licence or a start permission and licence from your country
 - * FIM Enduro World Championship Licence
- 3.4 You must attend administrative control BEFORE attending technical control
- 3.5 You must wear your wristband at all times – **NO WRISTBAND = NO RIDE!**
- 3.6 Please note the remainder of your entry fee is to be paid in cash due to signal issues on site
- 3.7 Only ONE person (the rider) to attend administrative control
- 3.8 If you have purchased any merchandise this can be collected from the merchandise tent
- 3.9 **There is a £20/€20 refundable deposit required for your transponder which needs to be paid for at administrative control.**

3.10 Transponders

You will receive your transponder at technical control

If you do not return your transponder, you will be charged an extra **£80/€80** to replace this.

You need to return your transponder to the merchandise tent after your race to get your refundable deposit back.

If you retire the race early, you must also return your transponder to the merchandise tent

Your transponder needs to go on the RIGHT FORK OF YOUR BIKE

3.11 You can walk the track from Friday 12noon – you will be given a map on arrival to help you navigate, there will also be spectator signs throughout the site.

NO MOTORCYCLES / ELECTRIC BIKES ALLOWED– Walking, bicycle and ebikes only

4. Technical Control

Technical control will be in front of riders paddock on

- Friday 9th May 2025 from 12:00 – 21:00

There will be a 3x3 tent with scrutineering flags visible

**NO ELECTRIC BIKES ARE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN OUR EVENT
NOR DO WE ACCEPT THESE ON SITE**

YOUR VANS/VEHICLE WILL BE CHECKED ON ARRIVAL

5. Pitting, refuelling & jet washing

- Pitting – Your pits for the main race/s will be at the refuelling area (Please see website “Pits Layout”)
 - If refuelling is required outside of race time this can be done at your vans
 - **All refuelling MUST take place on an environmental mat which you must supply**
 - You must have a fire extinguisher with you when refuelling
 - NO jet washing is to be done at your van – there is a dedicated area for this*

6. Race Format

YOU MUST BE AT THE START LINE 30 MINS PRIOR TO EACH RACE

VALLEYS XLITE – 8:30 – 10:30 Saturday

- 2hr multi lap race – Race stops at 2hour mark
- 5-6mile course
- Start line will be in class order (First come, first lined up)
- 25 riders in a row
- Start will be Engines Off
- 1minute intervals between each class set off
- Each class will be brought forward to the official ‘Start Line’

QUALIFYING AM – 11:30 – 13:30 Saturday

- 4mile course
- Class order (first come, first lined up)
- Start one by one – drop of flag
- 5 second intervals between riders* (*Subject to change)
- Start will be Engines on
- 3 laps –
 - 1st lap - Practice run
 - 2nd lap – Timed
 - 3rd lap – Timed

Fastest time from 2nd and 3rd lap counts as your qualifying time

THE TOP 48 RIDERS WILL PROCEED TO THE KNOCKOUTS TO BATTLE FOR A BETTER START POSITION ON SUNDAYS RACE

Riders in 49+ place will proceed straight through to Sundays race starting from row 5+ in their qualifying position

QUALIFYING PM – 13:30 – 15:30 Saturday

- 4mile course
- Class order (first come, first lined up)



- Start one by one – drop of flag
- 15 second intervals between riders in championship/Pro class, 10second intervals between riders thereafter* (*Subject to change)
- Start will be Engines on
- 3 laps –
 - 1st lap - Practice run
 - 2nd lap – Timed
 - 3rd lap – Timed

Fastest time from 2nd and 3rd lap counts as your qualifying time

THE TOP 48 RIDERS WILL PROCEED TO THE KNOCKOUTS TO BATTLE FOR A BETTER START POSITION ON SUNDAYS RACE

Riders in 49+ place will proceed straight through to Sundays race starting from row 5+ in their qualifying position

AM KNOCKOUTS – 16:30 – 18:00 Saturday

Sunday AM Race – 8:30 – 11:00 Sunday

- 6/7 mile course
- 2hrs or 2 laps* (whichever comes first)
- Start line - Row 1 - x12 riders from Superfinal Knockouts result will choose pick of the line in knockout result order. I.e. 1st place will choose their start line position, and so on...
- Row 2 will be x12 riders from Heat Two – first come first pick of the line
- Row 3 & 4 will be x12 on a row based on position from Knockouts Heat One – first come first pick of the line
- Row 5+ will be riders from Saturdays AM qualifying in qualifying position – rows of 20 – first come first lined up
- Engines Off
- Mass start starting from your row
- 1minute intervals between each row
- Siren start
- *You must cross the Red Bull Arch timing point before the 2.5hr mark to be able to proceed to the last hill to the finish podium – You will have an extra 20minutes to complete this. This will be classed as your finish line
- Riders who did not qualify on Saturday will start at the back of the grid

All riders times will convert back to the last correctly passed checkpoint if you come through finish or Checkpoints after 2.5hrs

Sunday PM Race – 12:00 – 16:00 Sunday

- 6/7 mile course
- 4hrs or 4 laps* (whichever comes first)
- Extra Hard Extreme sections on lap 3& 4 (Look out for the signs) The onus is on you. There will be extra timing points in this area. **If these are not passed you will be disqualified**
- Start line - Row 1 - x12 riders from Superfinal Knockouts result will choose pick of the line in knockout result order. I.e. 1st place will choose their start line position, and so on...
- Row 2 will be x12 riders from Heat Two – first come first pick of the line
- Row 3 & 4 will be x12 on a row based on position from Knockouts Heat One – first come first pick of the line
- Row 5+ will be riders from Saturdays PM qualifying in qualifying position – rows of 20 – first come first lined up
- Engines Off
- Mass start starting from your row
- 1minute intervals between each row



- Siren start
- *You must cross the Red Bull Arch timing point before the 4hr mark to be able to proceed to the last hill to the finish podium – You will have an extra 20minutes to complete this. This will be classed as your finish line
- Riders who did not qualify on Saturday will start at the back of the grid

All riders times will convert back to the last correctly passed checkpoint if you come through finish or Checkpoints after 4hrs

There are additional timing points after the checkpoints in Lap 3 & 4 and this will be the reverted time timing point if you are timed out within 4hr mark.
