Supplementary Regulations:
Valleys Hard Enduro, Wales UK, 2025 – AM RACE AND VALLEYS LITE RACE

License Holders competing in the event are forced to act in accordance with:

- the Sporting Code of the ACU (incl. all appendices)
- Supplementary Regulations as follows
- and any instructions by the Clerk of the Course during the event

2) Registration

All contenders must make an entry in writing by an “electronic” entry form available on the website

Riders must be age 14+

‘Guidance’

Youth riders aged 14 and 15 competing in the adult class – previous experience of trials, hare and hounds or sprint enduros is recommended. Riders are responsible for entering a class according to their ability.

- a) 14 years of age – restricted to a maximum machine capacity of 125cc.
- b) 15 -16 years of age - restricted to a maximum machine capacity of 250cc. max 4stroke

Registrations will become valid once:

- The event fee has been received on the announced account.
- The entry form has been signed online.
- The competitor has signed the disclaimer online
- All riders can obtain an **ACU License on the day or a yearly license through ACU website**
- All overseas riders have obtained a start permission and license from your country

There will be a refundable deposit for your transponder of £20/€20 – You need to return this after the race to get your refund. If this is not returned you will be charged an extra £80

3) Administrative Control

Administrative Control will take place at **Walters Arena, Race Venue**
Friday 9th at 12:00 - 21:00

All competitors must submit:

- ACU License / Fim license and start permission from your country

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- During Administrative Control, transponders and mounting instructions will be distributed.
- The numbers must go above the motorcycle headlight
- The number will remain the same throughout the entire race.

4) Technical Control

Technical Control will take place at **Walters Arena, Race Venue** on **Friday 9th May 12:00 – 21:00**

4.1) Street Legality / Tires

The entire event **Valleys Hard Enduro** takes place on private land:

- Motorcycles don't have to be street legal.
- No restriction on tires.

5) Event Format: Valleys Hard Enduro

SATURDAY: Morning 8:30am – 10:30am

Valleys X-Lite Race – 2hr multi-lap race (Standalone race)

Starting Procedure: You will start in class order on a first-come, first-lined-up basis. Dead Engine Start.

Siren start/drop of the flag

1minute intervals per row – 25riders on a row

Format: 2hr multi-lap

Course: Approx. 5/6-mile course

**There is a maximum capacity of 300 entries for this race*

Saturday AM Racers - QUALIFICATION – Duration 2hrs - (11:30 – 13:30 pm)

Starting Procedure: You will start in class order on a first-come, first-lined-up basis. Engines on. Drop of flag, 5-second intervals per rider* *Subject to change

Format: 3x Single laps, qualifying sprint runs

1st lap – sighting lap

2nd & 3rd lap – timed laps = Fastest time counts

Course: Approx. 4-mile mix, flowing and extreme course

The top 48 ranked riders will proceed to The Knockouts on Saturday evening (see sketch below)

(The result from The Knockouts will determine your race position on Sunday morning in rows of 12)

Riders ranked 49+ will proceed straight to the AM race on Sunday (from your position from Saturday morning qualification results from row 5 back...)

SATURDAY – THE KNOCKOUTS: Evening (16:30 – 19:30)

AM RACERS (16:30 – 18:00)

Starting Procedure: Heat races: Row of 12 riders, the start is signaled by a red light/siren/flag



Course: 1-mile extreme course in the arena.

All riders will start from the same start line (You will be called forward from your row to the start line)

Result:

The top 12 from AM Knockouts will start on the front row on Sunday races

The next 12 riders will go on row 2 and so on...

Riders positioned 49+ will start in rows of 20 on Sunday's race, starting from Row 5

PRIZE-GIVING

Valleys XLite – 11:00am Main Marquee

Top 3 in each class will receive an award

1st, 2nd & 3rd overall will receive a plaque

All awards and plaques MUST be collected at the event – any awards or plaques not collected will incur a charge to be posted

The Knockouts - 20:30 Main Marquee

Awards for the top 12 in The Knockouts (AM ONLY)

Entertainment / Music – 21:00 – Main Marquee

5.1) Sunday: Main Race

AM Race: (8:30am – 11:00am) – *There is a maximum capacity limit of 150 riders for this race*

Format:

2 laps within 2.5hrs - Race with several checkpoints on an extreme course.

After 2.5hrs all checkpoints will be closed, and the riders will be ranked by correctly passed checkpoints during that period with a last hill extreme to the podium

Course: Approx. 6/7 Mile extreme course

Starting Procedure:

Top 12 from The Knockouts will start on front row

The next 12 riders will go on row 2 and so on...

Riders positioned at 49+ will start in rows of 20 from row 5

1 minute between each row.

The start will be ENGINES OFF signaled by red lights off/Siren/Flag



Assistance: Assistance is permitted by:

- Marshals (only for the interest of safety or to prevent blockages)
- Other riders in the same race

Checkpoints: Competitors will pass through multiple checkpoints & timing points throughout the race. After completing Lap 2 within 2.5hrs, you will proceed to completing an extreme hill climb to the finish podium. You will have an extra 20mins to complete this after 2.5hrs timeframe.

**You will not proceed to last hill to finish if passed through after the 2.5hr mark – Only 1st 2nd and 3^d place will be required to complete this if passed through the finish line after the 2.5hr mark)*

Result: Riders who pass the most checkpoints/laps the fastest within 2.5hrs will be the winner. Riders will be ranked according to the number of checkpoints/laps during this period. Only checkpoints/laps passed within the 2.5hrs will be counted.

PRIZE-GIVING –

Top 3 overall in the AM Race will receive a plaque – @ 3 Rocks Podium 11:15am approx.
